

Ice House Customers,

We fully understand that many of these protocols are inconvenient to say the least, but they enable us to accomplish our two main goals: returning the players/skaters to the activities they love, and doing our best as a business to keep our customers, our staff, and our families healthy.

- Anyone who is feeling under the weather should stay home.
- If you have been in contact with someone who has Covid-19, stay home.
- Masks are required for everyone in the rink, ***except athletes when on the ice.***
- Anyone entering the building must use the main lobby doors and stop for a temperature check.
  - If you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, you will not be permitted into the rink.
- Do not arrive for practices or games more than 10 mins before your scheduled start time. If you arrive sooner you will be asked to wait outside.
- Players and coaching staff must leave 5 mins after the end of the game or practice
- Players must dress at home or in the car, carrying in only skates, helmet, gloves and a backpack for personal items. Valuables should be left with parents. Players are not allowed to bring hockey bags in the rink.
- Goalies can arrive 20 mins before their practice or games and can bring in a hockey bag.
- Players will be assigned an area where they can put on their skates, leave their shoes, masks, and backpacks – no locker rooms will be used.
- No spectators are allowed in the building as per Executive Order NO. 187.
- Mite players can have one parent enter the rink to tie skates and remain for practices or games.
- Squirt players can have one parent enter the rink to tie skates, but that parent must leave during the practice or game and can return at the end of the scheduled ice time to help untie skates.
- Pee wee players and above, no parents are allowed in the building for practices or games.
- VISITING TEAMS playing at ICE HOUSE must send a copy of their USA Hockey Roster by Wednesday to the Avalanche team manager. The roster must include all players, on-bench coaches and team manager. This roster will be used to check players and staff into the building. People who are not on the USA Hockey roster will not be admitted into the rink.

- Figure skaters are allowed into the building 10 minutes prior to a scheduled session and must leave 10 minutes after their session.
- Individual and team skate tying areas are clearly marked all around the facility.
- Social distancing should be maintained by all parents and skaters when off the ice.
- We are limiting parents and family members in the building for all sessions:
  - For all figure skating activity, skaters 10 and younger are permitted one parent/family member in the building. No parents/family members will be permitted in the building
- We strongly encourage all figure skaters to "dress and drive".
  - Anyone who brings a skate bag into the building, MUST bring it with you to your scheduled rink and place it on the players bench while practicing/skating, unless it is being held by a parent.
- Only rostered team members and staff will be able to enter the building and remain for the game.
- No more than three on-bench coaches and team manager will be allowed in the rink and all must be listed on the USA Hockey
- **VISITING TEAMS** must send a copy of their **USA Hockey Roster** including all players, three on-bench coaches and team manager, by Wednesday to the Avalanche team manager. This roster will be used to check players and staff into the building. People who are not on the USA Hockey roster will not be admitted to the rink.
- For all rink rentals, there will be no assignment of locker rooms (must use designated dressing areas in rink)
  - Must provide rosters for all coaches and players in advance
